## YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE PROGRAM IF YOU ARE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING GROUPS:

## Young People:

- Young people aged between 17-19 years
- Not engaged in education or training for six months or more (less than 8 hours per week)

#### **Mature Participants:**

- Mature aged people between 20-64 years
- Unemployed for six months or more (less than 8 hours per week)
- Not engaged in education or training for six months or more (less than 8 hours per week)

#### Young People Impacted by the Justice System:

- Young people aged between 17-24 years
- Who have been, or are currently on, Youth Justice Orders

## **Asylum Seekers:**

- Aged between 17-64 years
- Individuals or dependents of individuals who meet the following criteria:
  - hold any humanitarian, protection of refugee visa in Australia; or
  - have applied for a humanitarian, protection or refugee visa and hold a bridging visa for this purpose; or
  - have made an application under s.417 or s.48b of the Migration ACT 1958 (Cth) which is yet to be determined and hold a bridging visa

Individuals must have a visa with study rights, and work right are required for programs that include work placement.

#### **Out of Home Care:**

- Aged 17-64
- A person that has a current or previous experience with Child Protection

# Who do we help?

- Parents returning to work
- Unemployed (you do not need to be on Centrelink benefits)
- People who feel isolated in their community
- Career changers
- Young people
- People returning to work after a long absence, for example after an injury; illness; carer responsibilities
- People escaping domestic violence

- Indigenous Australians
